The advent of the Muslims and the rule of the Sultans, Mughals and the British are also covered. The independence of Bangladesh is also discussed.

Students of this course learn to analyze disfiguration or change in manuscripts. The students are also introduced to modern concepts of manuscript editing.

BEN 3525 Modern Bengali Essays

Works of S. Wazed Ali, Yaqub Ali Chowdhury, Qazi Imdadul Haque and Dr. Lutfar Rahman are studied.

BEN 3626 Literary Forms, Rhetoric and Prosody

In this course, different literary forms, rhetoric used in Bengali poetry and prosody relating to Bengali poetry are studied.

BEN 3627 Literary Criticism

Criticisms in the oriental and modern western systems are studied.

BEN 3628 Comparative and Historical Linguistics

Different methods and branches of linguistics are studied, followed by an analysis of descriptive, historical and comparative linguistics with special reference to Bengali language.

BEN 3629 Modern Linguistics

Phonetics, Phonology, Morphology, Syntax, Semantics, Lexicography.

BEN 3630 Phonetics

Science of Phonetics with special reference to Bengali, Phonological Aspects of Bengali Language.

BEN 4731 Grammar

Grammar of Bengali Language with special reference to Standard Written Form (Shadhu riti) and Standard Colloquial Form (Chalita riti).
